## How to apply?

Applicants are required to hold a university degree based on at least 3.5 years of full-time studies (equivalent to 210 ECTS credits).

In addition, at least one year of professional experience in the area of human rights is expected - or one year of professional experience in a different field, in combination with practical experience in human rights work on a volunteer basis.

Certified fluency in English is required for admission.
